Mission Statement

Community Corrections Programs were created to divert felony offenders from the Tennessee Prison system and to provide necessary supervision and services to the offenders with the goal of reducing the probability of continued criminal behavior while maintaining the safety of the community.

In 1985, the State of Tennessee special legislative session created the program to reduce prison overcrowding. Community Corrections offers local courts increased options, assists victims, provides public service to local governments, and is cost effective.

Through the Community Corrections Programs, tax payers avoid paying the high costs of jail or prison for non-violent offenders. Average costs are less than \$5 per day for Community Corrections VS the higher costs of \$45 per day for incarceration. The felony offenders also pay supervision and community corrections fees to assist in the costs of the program. One year after a successful termination, less than 10% have been convicted of a new felony.
