Eligibility:

Individuals Must:

- Live in Tennessee
- Be Age 65 or Older with Functional Limitations
- Be Age 21 or Older with Physical Disabilities
- Meet Level 1 Nursing Home Eligibility as Determined by a Physician and by TennCare
- Meet Financial Eligibility as Determined by the Department of Human Services
- Meet Caregiver and Safety Plan Requirements as Determined by the local Area Agency on Aging and Disability
