Caring professionals supporting older and dependent adults as they recover from the trauma of abuse, neglect, exploitation and fraud.

Who may CREVAA help?

Tennesseans **60** years of age or older or dependent adults ages **18-59** who are crime victims

What is a crime?

- Physical Abuse
- Emotional Abuse
- Psychological Abuse
- Sexual Abuse
- Financial Exploitation

How may CREVAA help survivors?

- Emergency Assistance
- Safety Planning
- In-home services
- Information and referral
- Assistance Accessing Services
- Support during the legal process

Examples of Crimes:

- Caregiver Neglect (includes abandonment,)
- Financial or Economic Exploitation, Identity Theft and Fraud.
- Arson, Burglary, Robbery, Stalking and Harassment, violation of a court order
