





Fraudulent Telemarketing

Some people who call are **CRIMINALS**!

NEVER send money if they:

- Refuse to take "NO" for an answer
- Seem overly friendly for a stranger ... talk about personal matters ... and seem very concerned about your life and problems
- Congratulate you for being so lucky
- > Ask for money for a prize that they insist you "won"
- > Want to send a courier for your check
- Claim the company you "won" from is out of business, but they have your prize ... for a fee
- Tell you that they are Investigators, and <u>for a fee</u> will recover money you lost in a previous scam
- > Urge you to act now because their offer won't wait,
- > Claim there is <u>no time to send anything in writing</u>
- Guarantee that their proposed investment will work

NEVER buy over the phone from a stranger **NEVER** buy on impulse ... <u>ALL</u> offers can wait

Stay Mentally Alert and Answer by saying:

"Take me off your <u>Sucker List</u> and put me on your <u>Do Not Call List</u>."

Then <u>Hang Up</u> ... and <u>Immediately</u> report the call to:

- Your Local Law Enforcement Agency
- Your State Attorney General's office

Don't be polite to a <u>CRIMIMAL</u>!
