





- CBD is safe and well tolerated in humans

- Not associated with abuse potential






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














Diabetes

- 100mg Twice Daily




Heart

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


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


SUBLINGUAL - MISS FIRST PASS EFFECT

FDA Warning Letters

■ 91% of Products tested did not match label (2016)



Legal: Section 7606

- Federal legislation passed the 2014 Farm Bill
- Hemp grown according to Section 7606 does not fall under DEA jurisdiction
- Hemp grown according to Section 7606 is not considered Marijuana
- The acting head of the DEA Chuck Rosenberg confirmed publicly in front of a congressional hearing on April 6th, 2017
- CBD manufactured outside of Section 7606 protocols is illegal



Legal: Section 7606 Compliance Requirements for Distribution

- Partnership with a state agricultural organization
- or a partnership with a university
- THC concentration must be 0.3% or less
- CBD can only be extracted from the flower of the hemp plant



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Will I Fail A Drug Test? Original Full Spectrum CBD with (0.3% THC) It is possible. Creates a False Positive during a urine drug screen (UDS)

Will I Fail A Drug Test?

- THC FREE CBD Full Spectrum Products
- It is possible.
- Can cause a False Positive during a urine drug screen (UDS)



How Long Is It In The Body?

- Half Life 9-32 Hours
- Need about 7 days to clear the system



Conclusions

- Pharmacists should counsel and assistance with drug interactions and medication management
- We need more uninhibited research to be done
- Medical cannabinoids have a place in healthcare
- CBD may be an effective alternative for many patients
- Full Spectrum is more effective than isolates.
- Excellent safety profile
- Read the label and check the COA
- Only some CBD is legal
- Ready or not... CBD is coming!
